Subject : Appointment of Consultant for Research Vessels.

As per the clause 4.17 of above referred tender, the pre-bid meeting was held on 17th November, 2014. Following are the important amendments to the tender document as per the pre-bid meeting discussions and decisions of NCAOR. The amendments are applicable throughout the tender document wherever relevant. Also, all points of discussions, clarifications provided and amendments agreed by NCAOR are enclosed herewith as Annexure-I for reference and clarity.

Clause No.	Subject	Amendment
Section 2: 2.3.9	Visit of consultants	To add the following sentence to this clause: <i>Consultants to make four visits of not more than 3 days each at the request of NCAOR. Consultants may make any additional visits as required by him to complete the job without any additional cost. Visits may be either to Goa, New Delhi or anywhere in India.</i>
Section 4: 4.54	Bidbond validity	<i>The bidbond validity date to be read as <u>23rd May, 2015</u> instead of 23rd May, 2014.</i>
Section 4: 4.58	Workscope Completion time.	To read the first sentence is amended as: <i>Bidders must undertake to complete all aspects of the work and making available to NCAOR all deliverables and to the complete satisfaction of NCAOR for deliverables by <u>8 months</u> from the date of award of contract.</i>
Section 5: 5.2	Acceptance time for all deliverables.	To add a footnote below the table as: <i>NCAOR may obtain clarifications / modifications if any and accept the final deliverables within a period of 45 days of submission.</i>
Section 6: 6.5.1	Qualification / Experience of the bidders	To add one more clause as 6.5.1 (3): <i>In case of consortium bid, the consortium should comply with three-vessels-criteria given at 6.5.1 (2) as well as each member of consortium should have experience as design consultant for atleast one oceanographic research vessel or fishery research vessel of 70m or above. Further, each member of the consortium should fulfil requirements of 6.5.2.</i>

All other terms and conditions of the tender remain unchanged. Some clarifications are provided at Annexure-I also.
